



**PUBLIC NOTICE OF COMMUNITY CONSULTATION MEETING
FOR THE NORTH PIGEON LAKE AREA STRUCTURE PLAN**

Leduc County together with Dansol International, Trans America Group, and their associates, will be preparing an Area Structure Plan (ASP) for the part of the Pigeon Lake watershed that falls under the County's jurisdiction. Residents, landowners, area associations, and other stakeholders are invited to attend a project kick-off meeting to formally launch the North Pigeon Lake ASP on:

TUESDAY, MAY 26, 2009 6:30 pm – 9:30 pm
Thorsby Community Hall (4913 48th Ave., Thorsby)

The North Pigeon Lake Area Structure Plan is to be a long-range plan with a 25 year planning horizon. The purpose of the Plan is to arrive at a vision for the north end of the lake and its watershed area. To make the vision work, a planning policy framework will be developed. This framework will help the County manage change, both at the watershed and neighbourhood level, and will address water quality issues.

Three public conversations will take place to guide the development of the North Pigeon Lake Area Structure Plan. The first public event, on May 26, 2009, focuses on the health of the whole Pigeon Lake watershed. The intention is to identify clearly the factors within the Pigeon Lake watershed that affect lake health, and the actions that will improve lake health.

Two further events are also planned over the next few months. The second event will focus on land in Leduc County at Pigeon Lake, and the development of the Area Structure Plan. A third event will focus on testing whether a draft Area Structure Plan actually meets the needs of the lake and the community. At the three events, community residents, landowners, and all stakeholders are also invited to ask questions about the planning process and the objectives of the Plan.

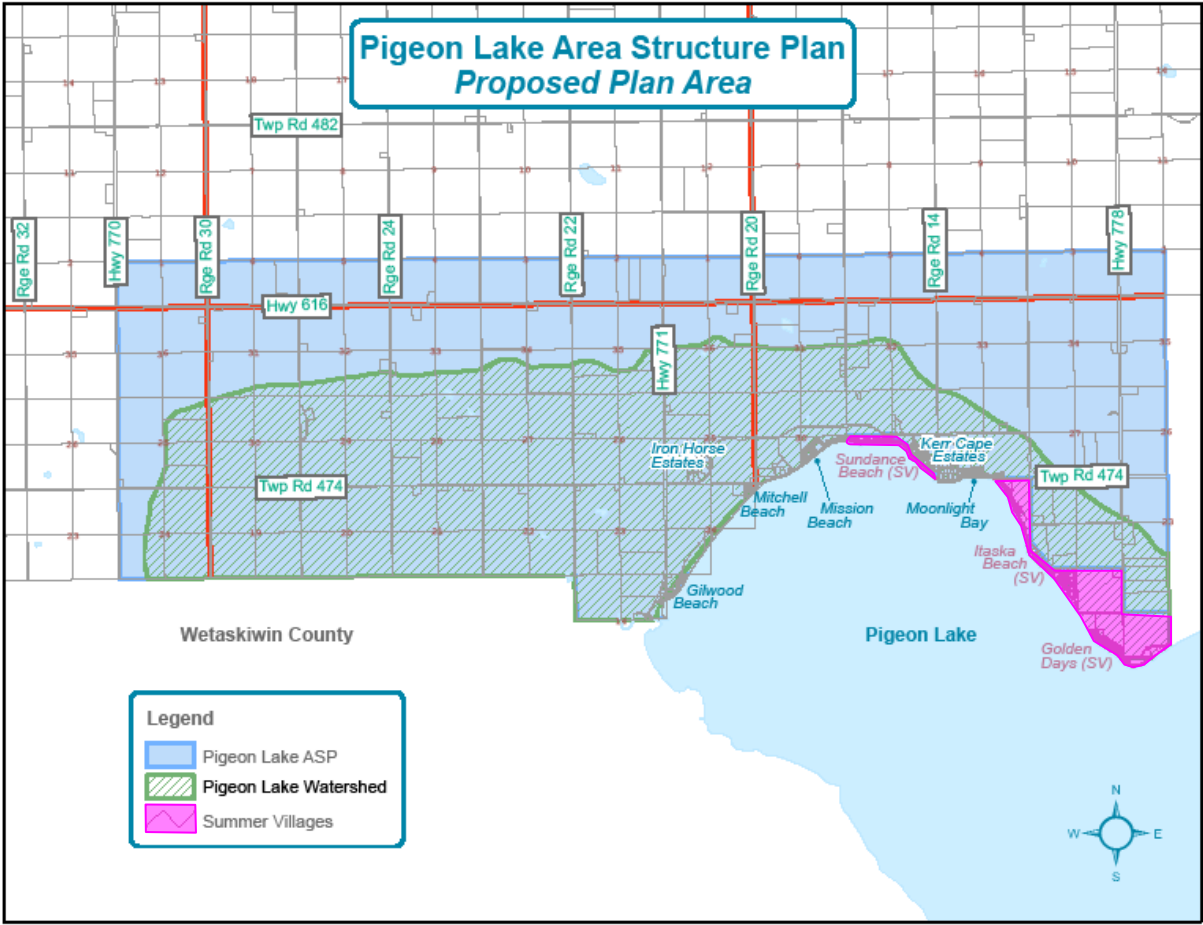
